Congratulations! You have been selected to exhibit your science study at the 2008 Greater St. Louis Science Fair – the largest Regional Science and Engineering Fair in the world!

The six important things you need to do are described below. As you read and complete each of the steps check it off, then keep this sheet for reference.

- 1.** An **EXHIBIT CARD** and **CLAIM CHECK** are located on the bottom of this form. The **Claim Check** is what you keep to identify yourself when you come to pick up your project at the end of the fair. **The Exhibit Card must be completed and placed on the bottom right-hand corner of your projects base at the time of placement for judging .**
- 2.** On the **CLAIM CHECK** please write your projects **ROW, POSition, and SEQUENCE NUMBER** which have been provided to you by your school's science fair coordinator or science teacher. Then **complete the required information EXHIBIT CARD** and cut it out and tape it to your projects base on the lower right-hand corner.
- 3.** When you arrive at Queeny Park on Monday, May 5th between 11:30 AM and 6:00 PM to place your project you will use the **ROW** and **POSITION** numbers located on the **Exhibit Card** to find the exact spot for your project. **YOU MUST** check in with one of the yellow shirted student volunteers **BEFORE** you put your project on the fair floor for judging.
- 4. SAFETY:** Your project must be safe. It **MAY NOT CONTAIN**—food, sharp items, breakables, liquids, powders, animals, body fluids, plants, microbes, inflammables, soils, batteries, or electrical hazards! If your study dealt with items such as these, **USE PICTURES! IF YOUR PROJECT required a Safety Approval, please have the Safety Form and Safety Approval Number form placed in the back of your logbook .**
- 5. VALUABLES :** Your project **MUST NOT CONTAIN ANY VALUABLE ITEMS** either in actual cost or valued by the exhibitor. The Fair IS NOT responsible for items that are damaged or stolen from a display.
- 6. EQUITY: YOUR PROJECT MUST HAVE** at least **A SELF-SUPPORTING BACK with AN ATTACHED BASE** . The display should be oriented forward, toward the viewer. The maximum **OUTSIDE** dimensions of the display **MUST NOT EXCEED** 60 cm deep, 67 cm wide and 120 cm height. No recognizable photographs of people or the names of people may be displayed that would enable the viewer to identify either the exhibitor or the exhibitor's school.
